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### LAGAVULIN, 8 YEAR OLD, SINGLE MALT ISLAY SCOTCH

*A lively and elegant Islay single malt that delivers a refined yet assertive smoky character, with aromas of sweet malt, lemon zest, and fresh sea air mingling with dry, earthy peat smoke. The palate is light yet intense, opening with citrus brightness and creamy vanilla before unfolding into peppery spice, roasted malt, and a clean medicinal smokiness. Its youthful vibrancy is balanced by subtle maritime salinity and a gentle mineral edge. The finish is long, dry and smoky with lingering notes of ash, pepper and a touch of citrus zest making it a bold yet approachable expression of Lagavulin's signature style.*

### CAOL ILA, 12 YEAR OLD, SINGLE MALT ISLAY SCOTCH

*A fresh and approachable Islay single malt that harmonizes gentle peat smoke with bright coastal character, offering aromas of citrus, green apple, and touch of brine alongside soft medicinal smoke. On the palate, it is smooth and medium-bodied, with sweet malt, lemon zest, and pear balanced by a clean, smoky dryness and subtle hints of olive oil and sea salt. The peat is more restrained than some Islay counterparts, allowing the crisp fruit and herbal undertones to shine. The finish is long, crisp, and smoky, with lingering citrus freshness and a delicate maritime salinity*

### KILCHOMAN, MACHIR BAY, SINGLE MALT ISLAY SCOTCH

*The flagship single malt from Islay's farm distillery, crafted mainly from ex-bourbon casks with a touch of Oloroso sherry, bottled at 46% and non-chill filtered. On the nose it opens with bright lemon zest, vanilla, and coastal brine, layered with peaches, pears, and gentle spice. The palate balances vibrant tropical fruits, honey, malt and butterscotch against a clean, ashy peat smoke, with hints of caramel and chocolate. The finish is long and elegant carrying citrus sweetness, cracked black pepper, sea salt, and lingering maritime smoke. It's a lively yet well-rounded dram, capturing essence of Islay in an approachable, fruit-forward style*

### HIGHLAND PARK, 21 YEAR OLD, 1994, MONTGOMERIE'S THE SINGLE CASK SELECTION, SINGLE MALT ORKNEY SCOTCH

*A refined Orkney single malt that showcases the distillery's hallmark balance of gentle smoke and sherried sweetness. The nose reveals honeyed malt, dried fruits, and heather, intertwined with soft peat smoke and polished oak. On the palate, it is elegant yet robust, offering layers of rich toffee, sultanas, and spiced orange, complemented by hints of leather, vanilla, and subtle maritime salinity. The peat is delicate and well-integrated, adding depth without overpowering. The finish is long and complex, with lingering notes of oak spice, dried fruit, and a whisper of heathery smoke, highlighting both maturity and finesse.*

### LEDAIG, 18 YEAR OLD, SINGLE MALT MULL SCOTCH

*A richly peated single malt from Tobermory Distillery on the Isle of Mull, offering a bold balance of smoke and complexity. On the nose, it opens with earthy peat smoke, seaweed, and rich oak, underpinned by sweet notes of dried fruit, toffee and dark chocolate. The palate is full-bodied and layered, combining maritime salinity and smoky bonfire embers with sweeter sherried influences of raisins, orange peel, and caramel, alongside hints of spice and leather. The finish is long, warming, and smoky, with lingering notes of spice, charred oak and subtle sweetness, making it a robust yet elegant dram*

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
