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THE BALVENIE 14 YEAR OLD – CARIBBEAN CASK

Type: Single Malt Scotch Whisky | Origin: Speyside, Scotland

Notes: Honeyed malt, creamy toffee, vanilla, and brown sugar with tropical fruit undertones.

Finished in Caribbean rum casks for a rounded sweetness and a smooth, mellow finish.

Smooth, approachable, and brimming with warmth, The Balvenie 14 is matured in traditional oak before finishing in Caribbean rum casks. Expect aromas of ripe tropical fruit — pineapple, banana, and mango — layered with vanilla and soft oak. On the palate, honeyed malt and creamy toffee lead into caramelized brown sugar and gentle spice. The finish lingers with mellow vanilla sweetness and a touch of peppery warmth, offering a dessert-like indulgence that remains effortlessly balanced.

MORTLACH 16 YEAR OLD

Type: Single Malt Scotch Whisky | Origin: Speyside, Scotland

Notes: Richly sherried with dark dried fruits, toffee, chocolate, and warm spice.

Full-bodied and bold, balancing sweetness with Mortlach's signature meaty depth.

A robust Speyside single malt that defines Mortlach's bold, meaty signature. Deeply sherried, this whisky opens with notes of dark dried fruits, raisin, and polished oak, accented by hints of tobacco and leather. The palate delivers brown sugar syrup, apricot, baked apple, and rich chocolate underscored by nutmeg and clove. The finish is long, with layers of dried fruit sweetness and a faint smoky savoriness — complex, commanding, and full of depth.

THE GLENLIVET 18 YEAR OLD

Type: Single Malt Scotch Whisky | Origin: Speyside, Scotland

Notes: Layers of apricot, caramel, honeyed malt, and gentle oak spice.

Refined and elegant with a long, warming finish of vanilla and dark chocolate.

Elegant and mature, The Glenlivet 18 balances refined oak spice with Speyside's hallmark fruitiness. Aromas of apricot, orange peel, and honey intertwine with vanilla and toffee. The palate is rich yet silky, offering notes of caramel, stewed apples, and spiced malt wrapped in subtle oak tannin. The finish is long and luxurious, fading into dark chocolate, raisin, and gentle spice — a perfect portrait of Speyside sophistication.

GLENFARCLAS 2011

Type: Single Malt Scotch Whisky | Origin: Speyside, Scotland

Notes: Dried figs, raisins, brown sugar, and toasted nuts over rich sherry sweetness.

Smooth, lingering finish with soft oak and hints of spice and leather.

Richly sherried and deeply satisfying, Glenfarclas 2011 embodies traditional Speyside warmth. On the nose, discover sultanas, figs, and honey-sweet malt laced with hints of rum-soaked cake. The palate reveals lush raisins, dark chocolate, and toasted nuts balanced by clove and pepper spice. It finishes smooth and lingering, with dried fruits, oak, and soft leather creating a harmonious close that showcases Glenfarclas's classic house style.

TORMORE 28 YEAR OLD – NECTAR OF THE DAILY DRAMS

Type: Single Malt Scotch Whisky | Origin: Speyside, Scotland

Notes: Stewed fruits, almond cake, vanilla syrup, and gentle baking spice.

Elegant, long, and dry finish with hints of coconut, waxy oak, and minerality.

A beautifully aged expression of Speyside elegance, this 28-year-old Tormore offers a gentle yet complex profile. The nose reveals dried apricots, almond cake, and vanilla syrup with hints of cherry and ginger. The palate unfolds in layers of stewed fruit, pear, and apple flan, enriched by rich vanilla and baking spice. The finish is long, dry, and gracefully bitter, leaving impressions of toasted oak, coconut, and waxy minerality — a truly distinguished finale to this flight.
